

Clinton Community YMCA at Prairie Passage - FAQ

When will construction of the new YMCA begin?

- Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2027
- We anticipate 18-20 months of construction

Why is the Aquatic center not being included in Phase One?

- While the addition of an indoor / outdoor pool (with community use) will not be part of Phase One, we are actively pursuing additional funding sources to build the pool in a later phase.

What will happen to the current YMCA facility?

- Once Phase One is completed, the current YMCA facility will be used for our Aquatic programming until Phase Two can be completed.

What amenities will the new YMCA have?

- 3 full basketball courts, 3 lane walk around track above the courts, wellness center / weightroom, group exercise room, childcare room and a community room.

Will membership cost more once the new YMCA opens?

- The Y operates under a model where new capital projects are fully funded through donations and partner sources. This means that the project costs will not influence our membership pricing model.

What additional programming do you expect to offer?

- With additional space, we do plan to offer more youth sports and adult sport programming.

Can my Strong Kids campaign contribution go toward the capital campaign instead?

- Strong Kids giving takes care of our annual commitment to be "for all" in the community. We are asking for a pledge above and beyond your annual giving. This is a once-in-a-generation project and we need once-in-a-generation sized gifts!

Do you have to have cash or a check immediately for the capital campaign?

- While upfront giving is best, capital campaign gifts can be spread over a multiple year pledge period.
